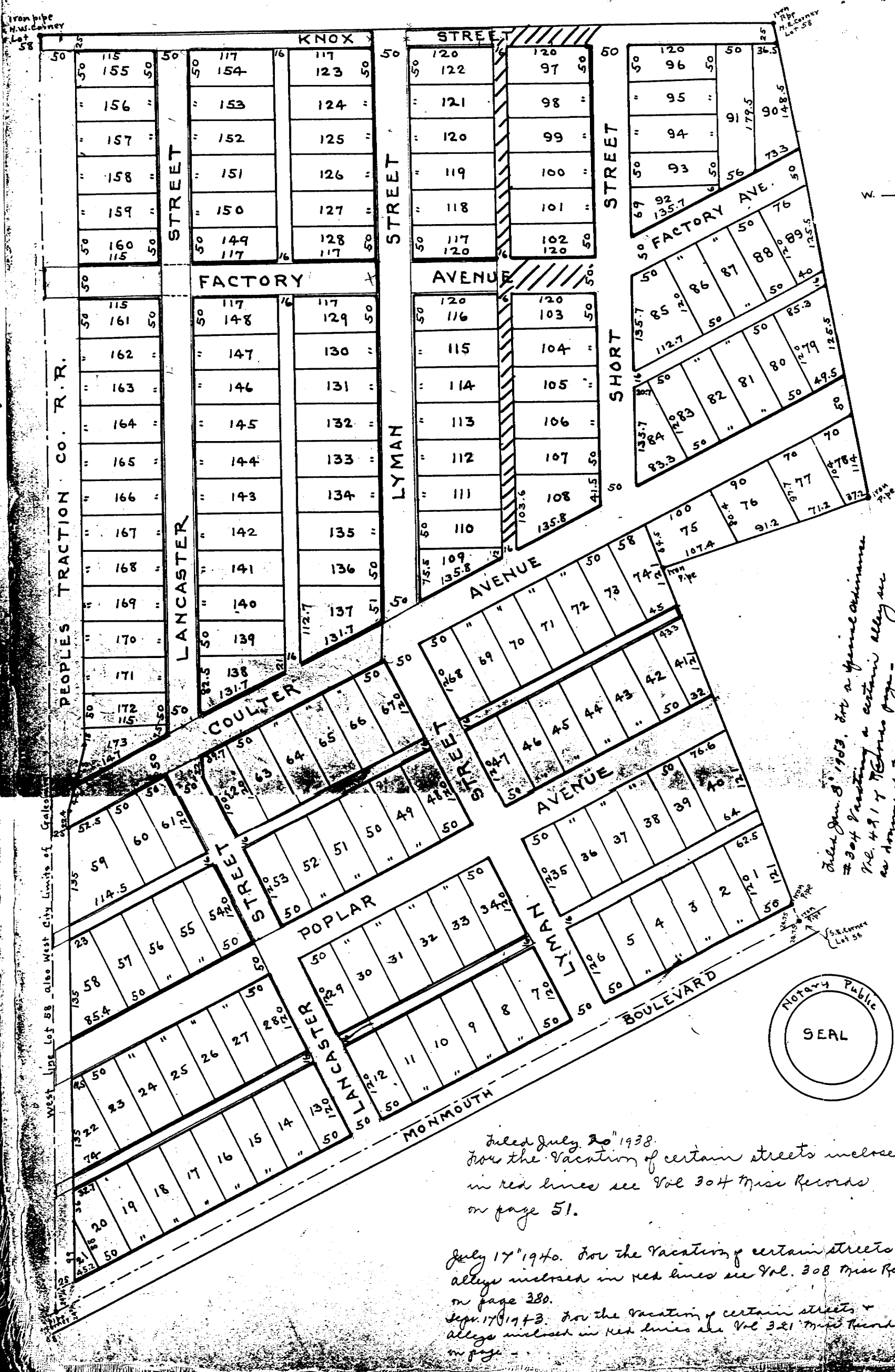


LIBERTY HEIGHTS

BEING A SUBDIVISION OF LOT 58 OF REVENUE PLAT 1908 OF A RESUBDIVISION OF THAT PART OF THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16 T.11N.R.1E. WHICH LIES NORTH OF THE CENTER OF MONMOUTH ROAD, AND SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, AND THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE A.T.&S.F.R.R. TOGETHER WITH THAT PART OF LOTS 31, 32 & 33 OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS PLAT OF THE NORTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, WHICH LIES SOUTH OF THE PRESENT RIGHT OF WAY OF SAID A.T.&S.F.R.R. AS NOW LOCATED. LIBERTY HEIGHTS BEING AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GALESBURG.

Knox County } Liberty Heights, being an addition to the City of Galesburg, and a subdivision
of Lot 58 of Revenue plat 1908 of a resubdivision of that part of the South-West
quarter of Section 16, Township 11 North, Range 1 East of 4th P.M., which lies
North of the center of Monmouth road, and south of the North line of the said
quarter section and the right of way of the A.T. & S.F.R.R. Together with that
part of lots 31, 32 & 33 of School Commissioners plat of the North-West quarter
of section 16 which lies south of the present right of way of the said A.T.&S.F.R.R.
as now located, the said Revenue plat being recorded in Volume 7 of plats, page 147
(This subdivision called Liberty Heights excepts that part of lot 58 on the West side
of said lot owned by the Peoples Traction Company) and the annexed plat truly
represents said subdivision.
Distances are given in feet and decimals of a foot, and in addition to the
monuments shown thereon, Iron pipes are driven at the corners of all blocks,
and on some lot corners.

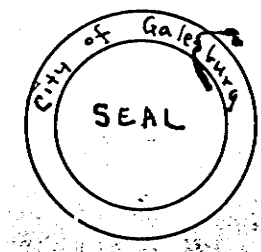
