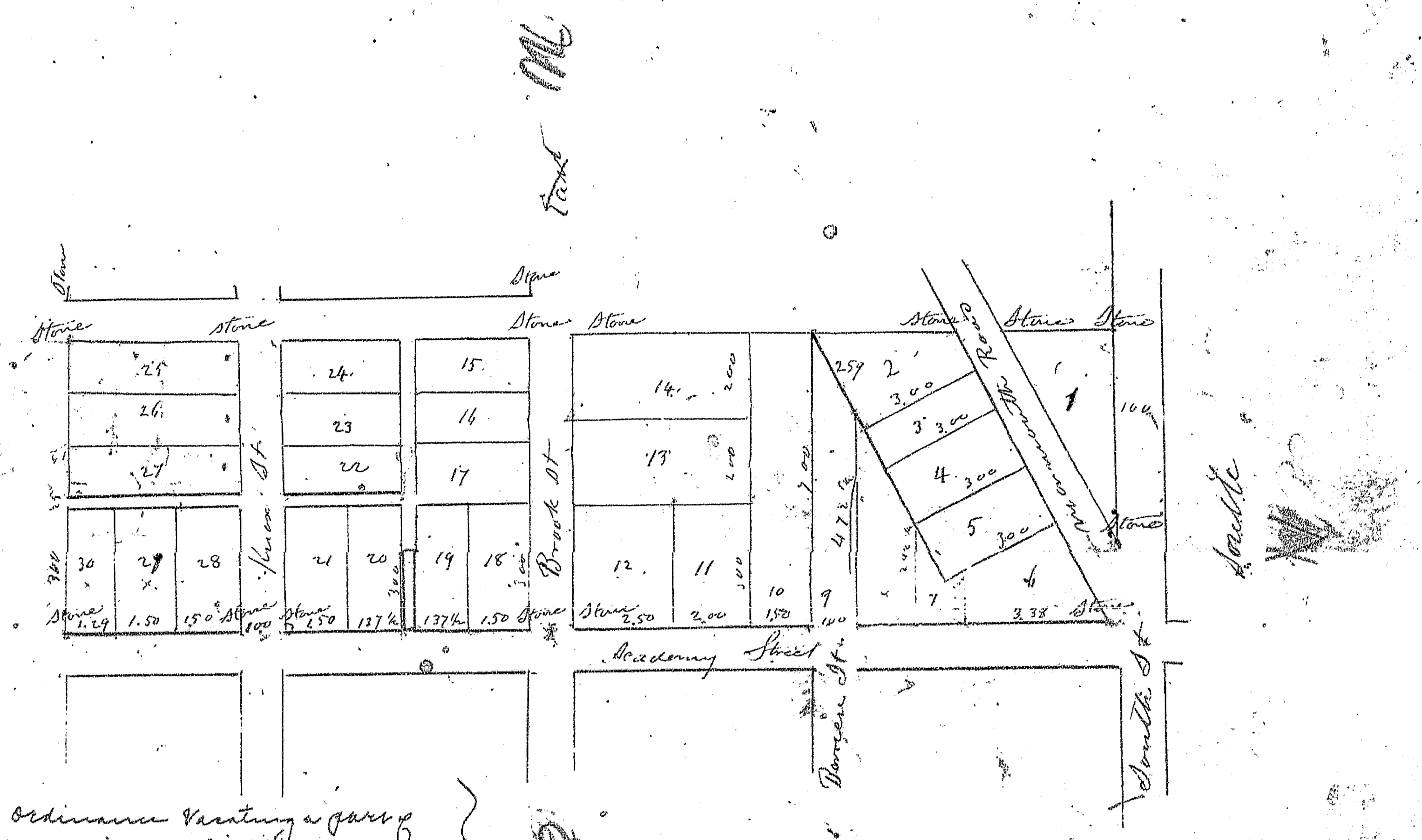

 This Indenture made this Third day of March
 in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty
 four between Benjamin F Allen and Mary Allen his wife
 of Maguan in the County of Knox and State of Illinois of
 the first part and Richard Scribner of the same place
 of the second part Witnesseth that the said party

of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred
 and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second
 part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant
 bargain and sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcels of land situated
 in the town of Maguan Knox County Illinois it being lot one and two
 in Block five in said town Together with all and singular the
 hereditaments rights privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in any wise appertaining To Have and to Hold the said premises
 as above described unto the said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns forever And the said party of the first part for themselves and their
 heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant to and with the
 said party of the second part his heirs executors administrators and assigns that
 he is well seized of the premises above conveyed as of a good and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance in fee simple And have good right to sell and
 convey the same in manner and form as aforesaid that the above described
 premises are free from all incumbrances And that the above described
 premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the
 second part his heirs or assigns Against the Claim of all persons whom
 soever they will forever warrant and defend.

 the said Benjamin F Allen having been by me made ac
 quainted with the contents of said deed and being examined
 separately and apart from her said husband acknowledged
 that she had executed the same and had relinquished
 her dower to the premises therein conveyed voluntarily
 freely and without any compulsion of her said husband
 and do not wish to retract
