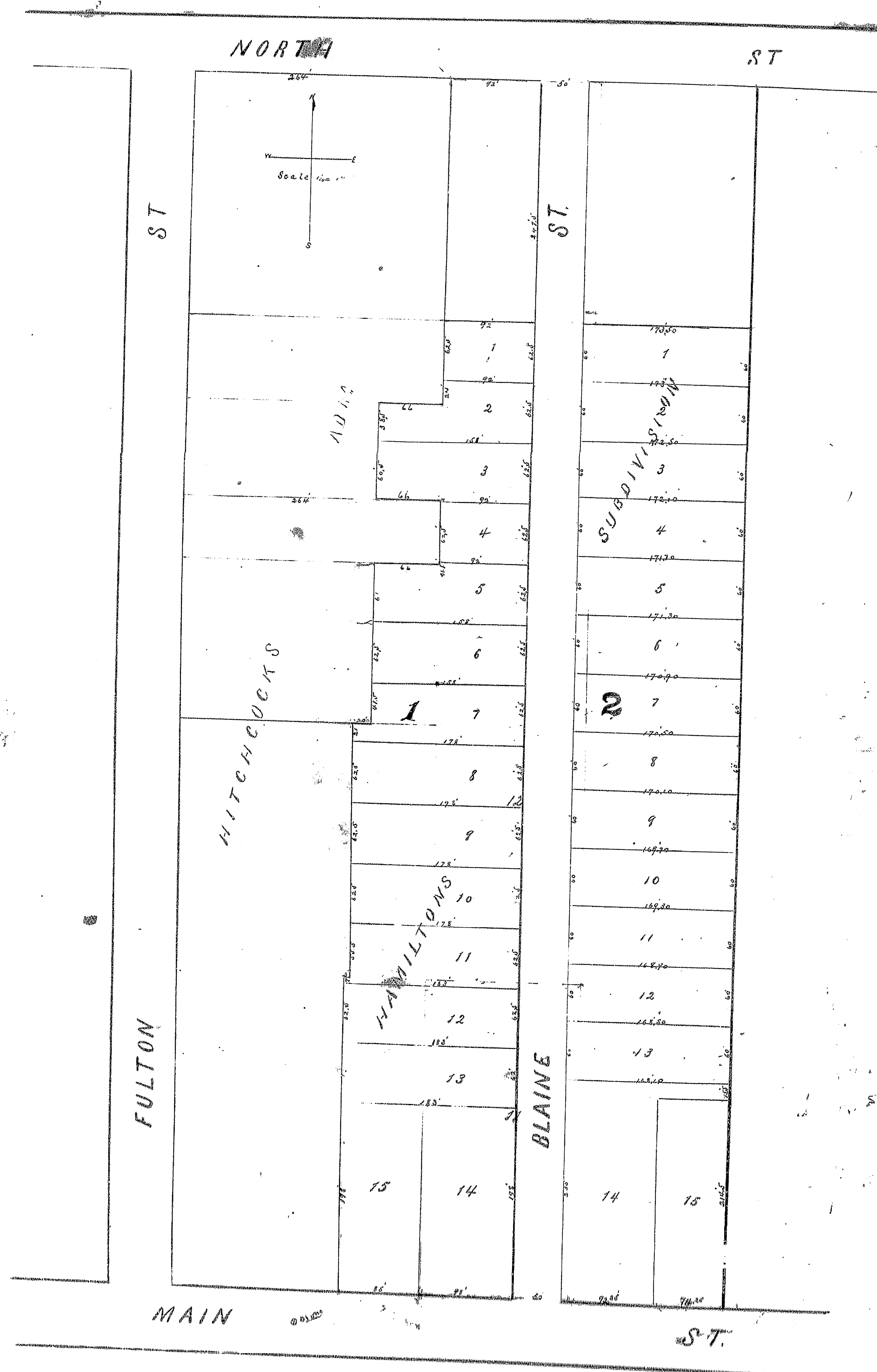


JOSIAH HAMILTON'S SUBDIVISION

The same being a subdivision of a part of the south quarter (1/4) of section number eleven (11) Township 7th North Range 1st East 1st North and of the East part of Hitchcocks Addⁿ to the City of Galena, Illinois (and more particularly described as commencing at a point 124 3/4 ft East of the stone at the South West corner of the said South East Quarter 1/4 of section Eleven (11) Thence East 314.5 feet Thence North 1543.0 ft. Thence West 395.5 ft. Thence South 86.5 ft. Thence West 66 ft. Thence South 11 ft Thence East 66 ft. Thence South 11 ft. Thence West 66 ft. Thence South 165 ft. Thence West 20 ft. Thence South 264 ft. Thence West 5 ft. Thence South 322.5 ft. Thence East 85 ft. Thence South 33 ft to the place of beginning. Blaine Street is 406.0 ft East of & parallel with Fulton Street and extends from Main St to North Street and is fifty (50) feet in width.
