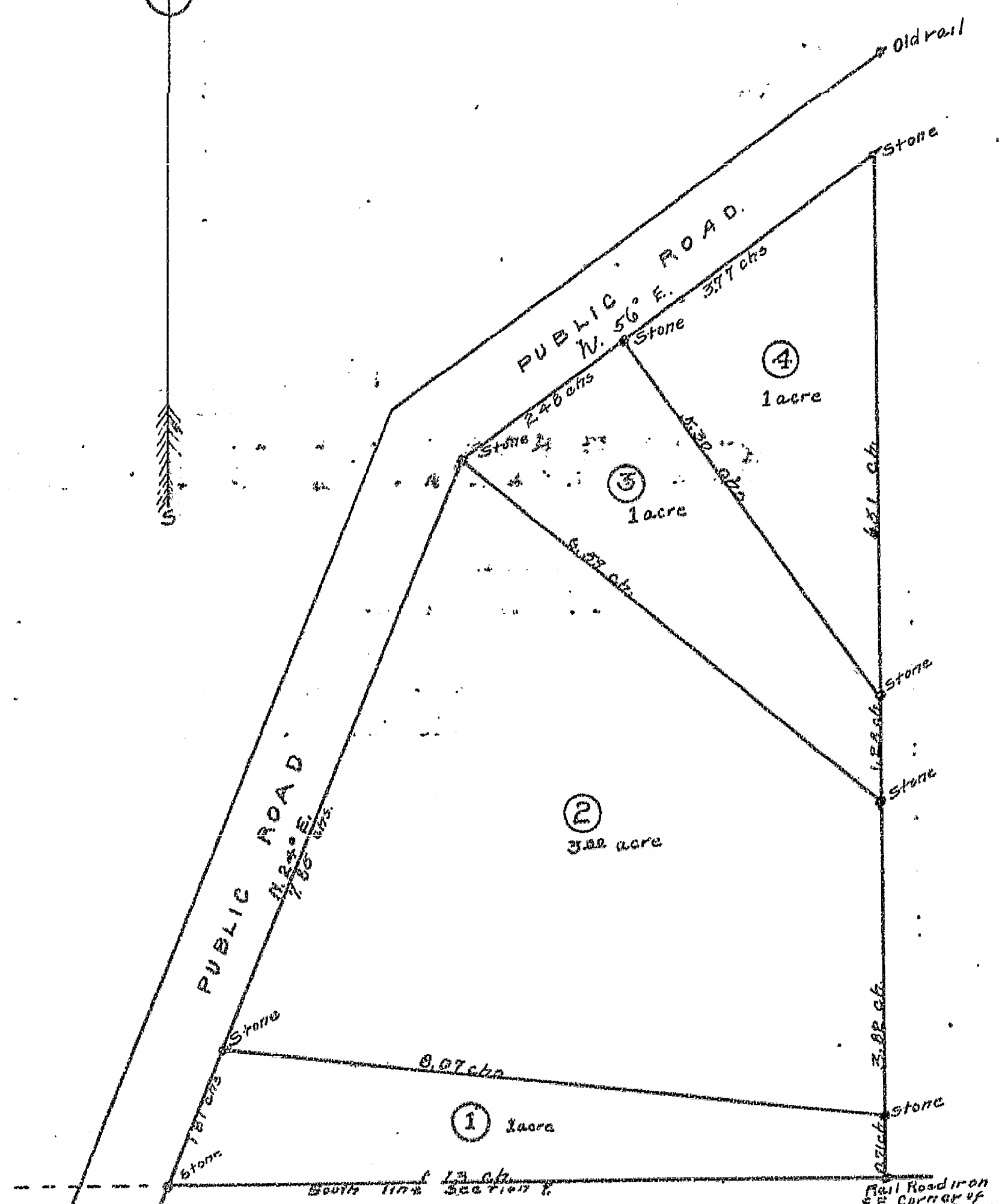
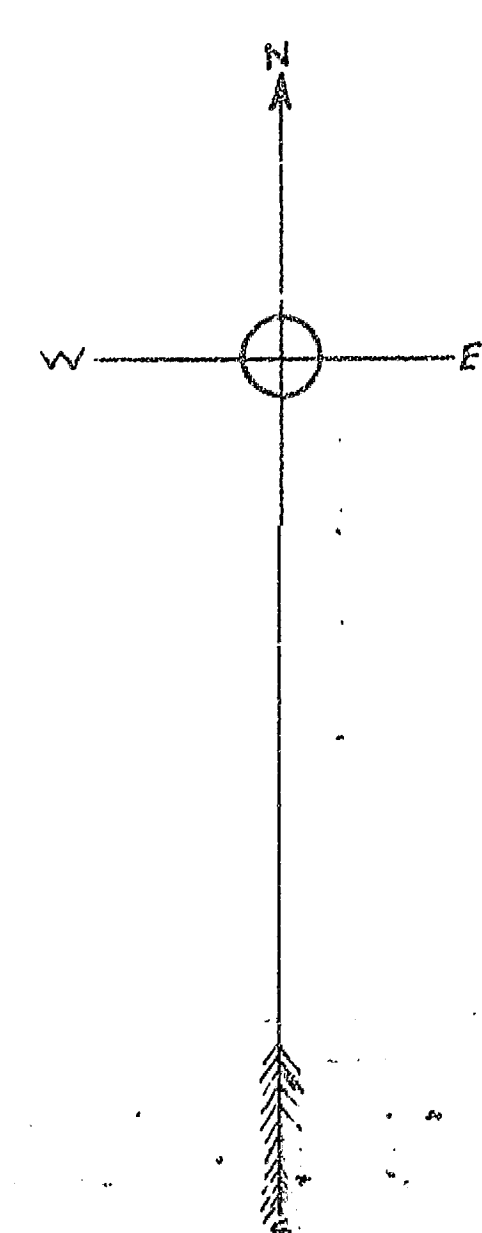


OF LOT 4 OF A RESUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 7, T.11N., R.2E.

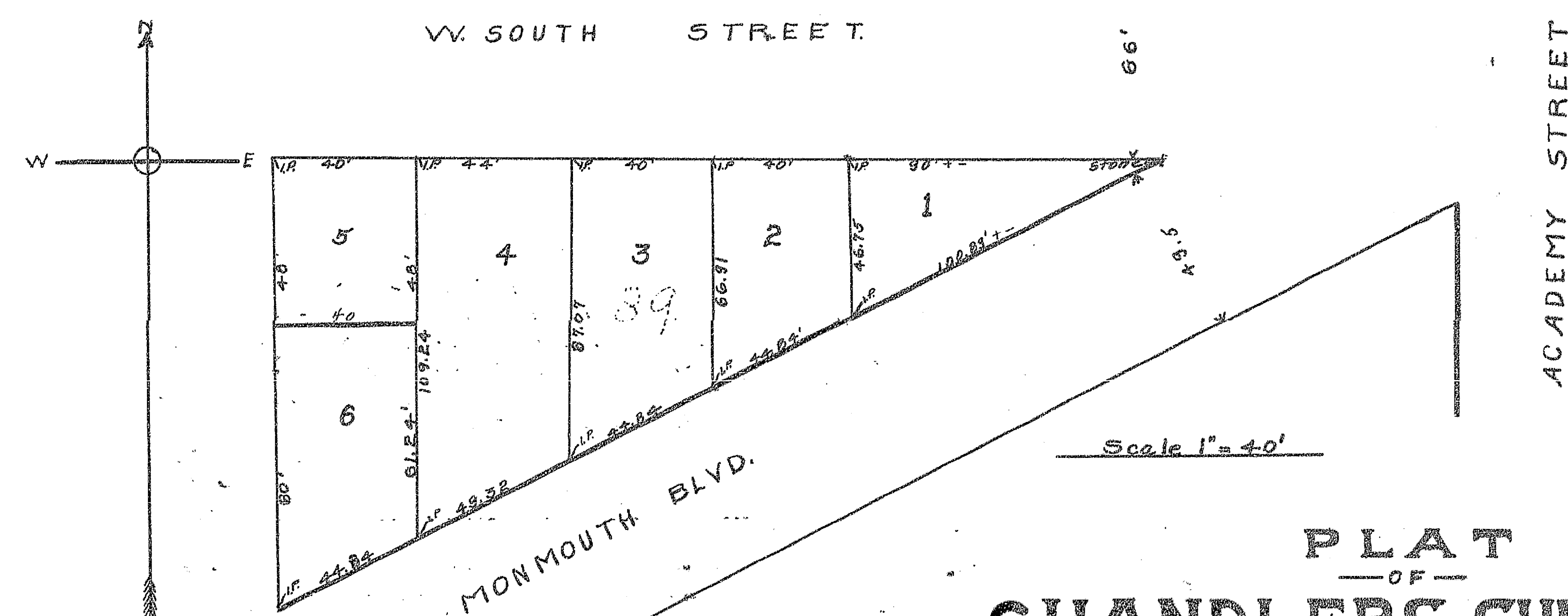
