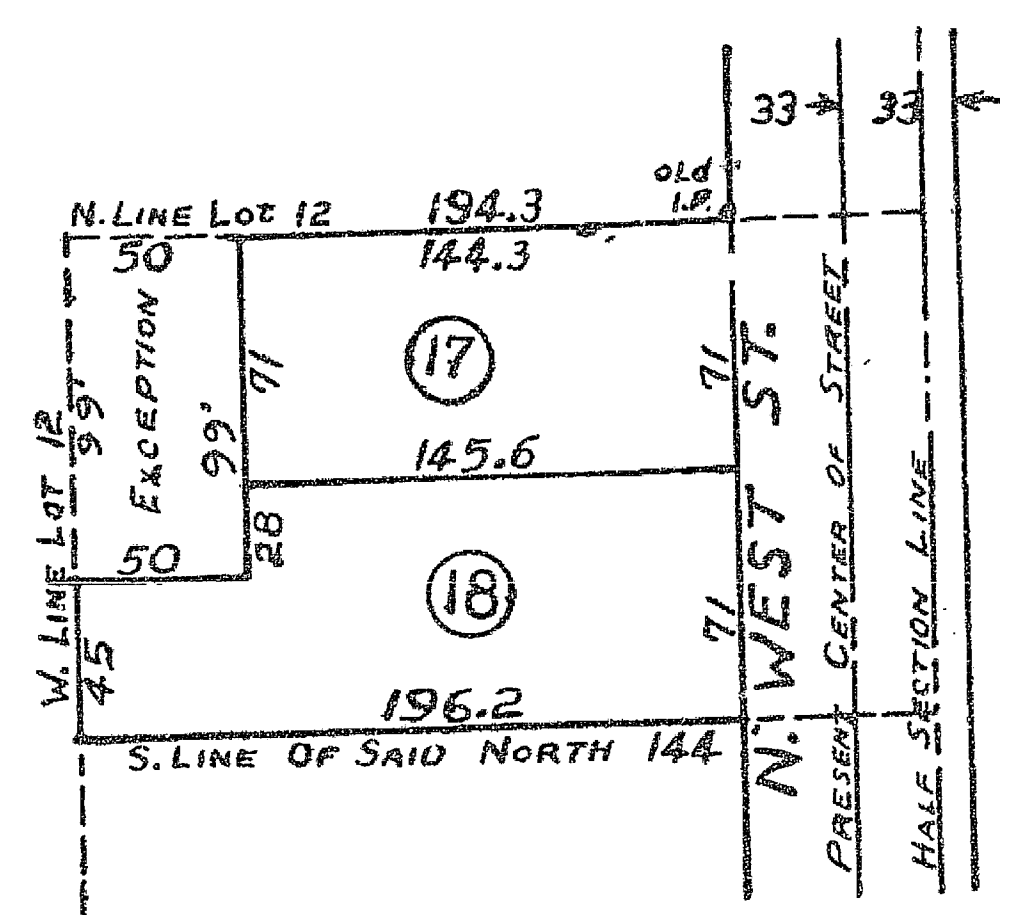


PLAT OF A RESUBDIVISION

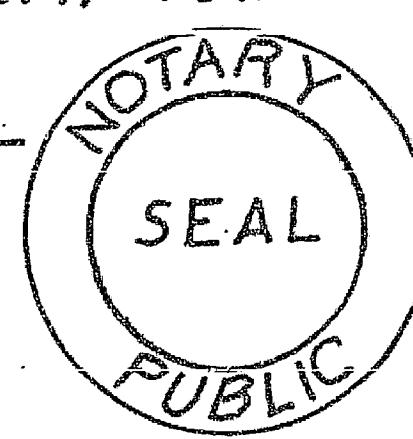
That we, the undersigned, owners of the land upon which said

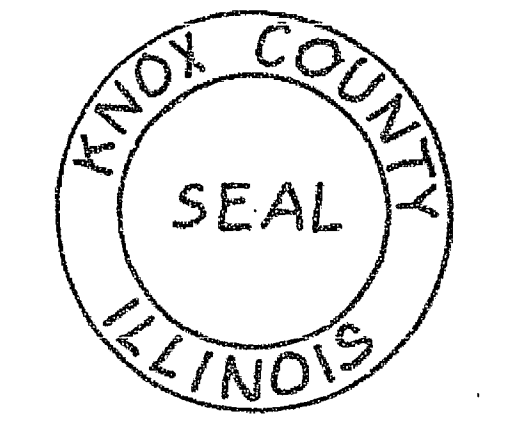

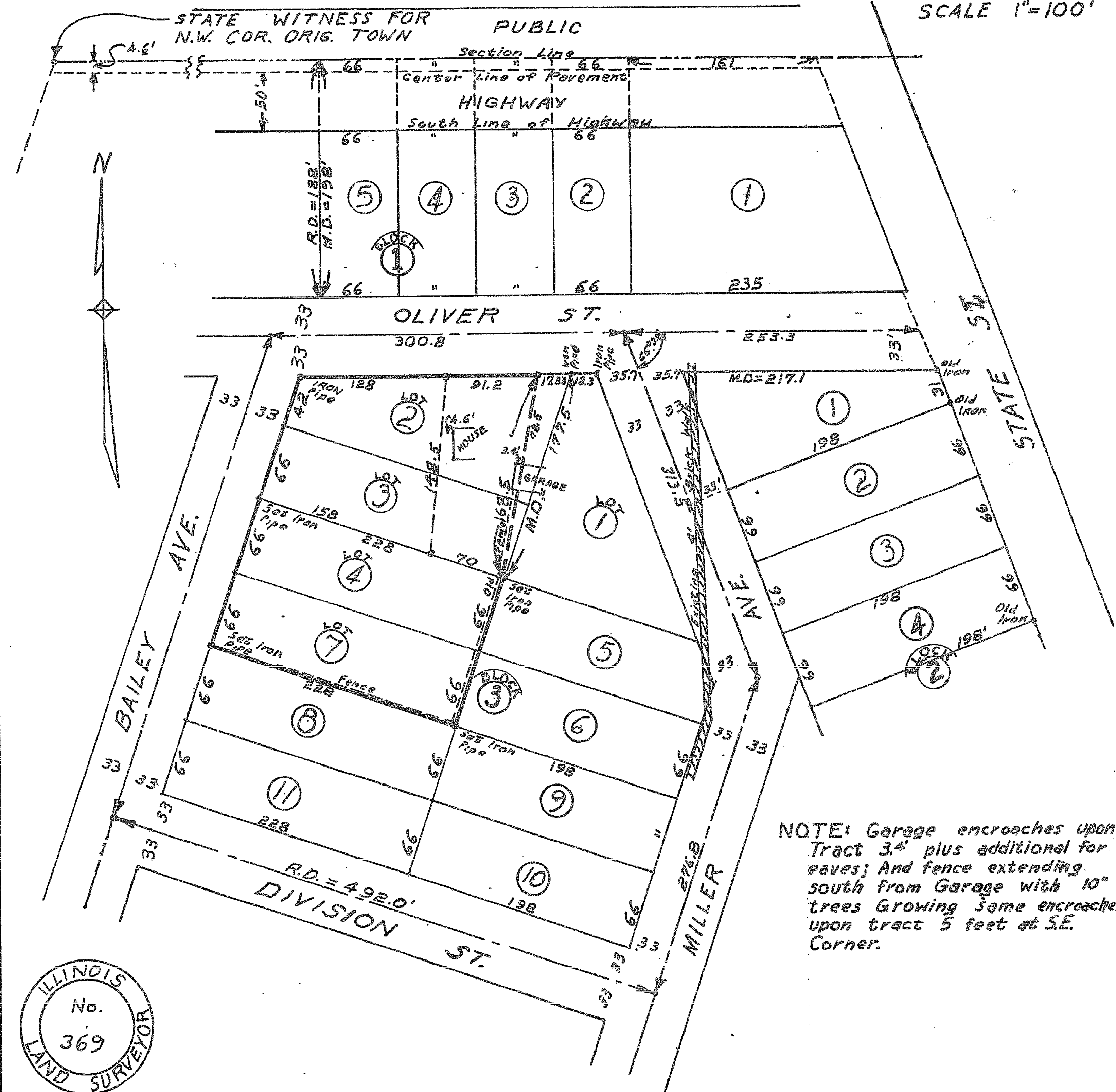

 distant from the Westerly line of orig. Town, T. Rail at SW Cor and State
 Witness at N.W. Cor said Town. The N.W. Cor. Block 3 net measure from
 Mattison St. Miller Ave. located record distance east of Bailey, and
 record distance from monuments noted on State Street, the North
 end of said Miller Ave. approximately 66 feet East of platted
 distances. I find no record of relocation of same as now used.
 Location of existing brick walk along the West line of Miller Ave.
